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Welcome

We are so excited for you to experience Extraordinary Living as a family! Our prayer is that you and your children will grow together and create a daily habit to read the Bible, have eternal conversations, and pray together. We hope this resource blesses you and your family. Here are a few helpful things to know:

There is **one** devotional per day to provide a daily connection with God by reading the memory verse.

We encourage you to do this devotional at the same time every day with your child. This will create consistency and help them grow in their relationship with you and God.

The daily devotionals are designed for your children to read Scripture, understand what they read, apply what they learned, and pray. Each day consists of the following format:

- **Weekly Memory Verse**

The weekly memory verse is the same as your weekly memory verse in the adult book. Read it out loud with your child each day so you can grow in God's Word together.

- **Weekly Main Point**

The weekly main point is a summary of the weekly memory verse.

- **Activate!**

This section allows your child to apply the memory verse and main point with a fun activity or reading.

- **Parent-Child Connect Question**

This is one of the most important components of this devotional. Each day, a question related to the memory verse is provided for you and your child to discuss. This is a great opportunity for you and your child to talk about God and connect on a deeper level.

- **Pray Together**

Prayer is how we daily talk to and connect with God. Each day, a brief prayer topic is included that relates to the memory verse. You can choose to use this topic for prayer with your child, or pray about something else. The important part is that both you and your child take turns praying to create a habit of spending time in prayer every day. Praying with family is a good start, but this should ultimately lead to an individual's habit of prayer.
