What is Fasting?

The goal of fasting is not just to go without food; it is to draw nearer to God. The definition of a biblical fast is *to restrict food for a spiritual purpose*. Fasting is not just an exercise for the super-spiritual, but it should be a periodic discipline in the life of every believer.

The constant demands and pressures of daily life on your mind, will, and emotions can weigh you down and cause you to lose focus. This can cause you to feel spiritually sluggish and desensitized.

Fasting is a way for you to celebrate the goodness and mercy of God. It is also a way to prepare your soul to expand and contain the fresh new purposes God desires to bring into your life.

Choosing The Right Fast for You

Your personal fast should present a level of challenge. However, it is very important to know your own body, know your options, seek God in prayer, and follow what the Holy Spirit leads you to do.

NORMAL FASTS

A normal fast is when only water is consumed. This would be the type practiced by Elijah (see 1 Kings 19:8) and Jesus (see Matthew 4). They abstained from food for 40 days. The length of time for any fast is a personal decision.

PARTIAL FASTS

A partial fast is when some foods are restricted. Two of the most common partial fasts are:

1. JUICE FAST

A juice fast is when vegetable and fruit juices are consumed instead of solid food. Some include protein powder in their liquid plan as well. Substituting liquids for one or two meals is an alternative.

2. DANIEL FAST

A Daniel Fast is based on the fasting principles of the prophet Daniel. Daniel 1 states that he consumed only vegetables and drank only water, and Daniel 10 states that he ate no rich (or choice) foods, as well as no meat or wine. Visit daniel-fast.com to learn more.

Remember, the power of fasting has less to do with food and more to do with setting yourself apart for a specific period of time to focus more on the Lord, prayer, and worship.

SALVATION / BAPTISM

“Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.”
- **Mark 16:15**

I walk by faith, not by sight.

Romans 10:17 — *So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the Word of Christ.*
Faith comes from hearing the Word.

Hebrews 11:1 — *Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.*
Faith is the substance of hope, the evidence of things unseen.

Philippians 4:6-7 — *Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your request be known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your heart and your minds in Christ Jesus.*

Your peace guards my heart and mind when I pray and give thanks. I am not anxious.

You are always with me and therefore, I am not afraid.

Romans 8:28 — *And know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.*

John 14:27 — *“Peace I leave with you; it is my own peace that I gave you. I do not give it as the world does. Do not be worried and upset; do not be afraid.”*

FREEDOM

John 8:36 — *“Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.*

Romans 6:18-22 — *And having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness. I speak in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves of uncleanness, and of lawlessness leading to more lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves of righteousness for holiness. For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. What fruit did you have then in the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life.*

I am a slave to righteousness, resulting in eternal life.

Romans 8:1 — *There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.*

I am no longer condemned because Christ lives in me.

Galatians 5:1 — *Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.*

I will stand firm because I am set free from the yoke of slavery.

Psalms 146:7 — *Who executes justice for the oppressed, Who gives food to the hungry. The Lord gives freedom to the prisoners.*
I am no longer a prisoner to sin because Christ has liberated me from the power of sin.

Isaiah 58:6 — *“Is this not the fast that I have chosen: To loose the bonds of wickedness, To undo the heavy burdens, To let the oppressed go free, And that you break every yoke?”*

My chains are gone. I’ve been set free.

HEALING

Matthew 9:35 — *And Jesus went throughout all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease and every affliction.*

Jesus can heal every sickness and disease among us.

Psalm 103:3 — *“Who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases.”*

God forgives all my iniquities and heals all my diseases.

Psalm 107:20— *He sent out His Word and healed them, and delivered them from their destruction.*

God sends His Word to heal me.

James 5:15 — *And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.*

The prayer of faith will save the sick and the Lord will raise them up.

Isaiah 53:5 — *But He was pierced for our transgressions; He was crushed for our iniquities; upon Him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with His wounds we are healed.*

By His stripes, we are healed.

Matthew 8:16-17 — *That evening they brought to Him many who were oppressed by demons, and He cast out the spirits with a word and healed all who were sick. This was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophets Isaiah: “He took our illness and bore our diseases.”*

Jesus took our infirmities and bore our sickness.

Proverbs 17:22 — *A joyful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones.*

My joyful heart will help like good medicine.

Matthew 12:15 — *Jesus, aware of this, withdrew from there. And many followed Him, and He healed them all.*

Great multitudes followed Jesus and He healed them all.

I know that all things are possible to those who believe.

John 1:12 — *But to all who did receive Him, who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God.*

I am a child of God.

John 15:16 — *"You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, He may give it to you."*

I am called and chosen by God.

Romans 5:1 — *Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.*

I have been justified.

1 Corinthians 6:17 — *But he who is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with Him.*

I am one spirit with God.

1 Corinthians 6:20 — *You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.*

I have been bought with a price. I belong to God.

Ephesians 1:5 — *He predestined us for adoption to Himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of His will.*

I have been adopted by God.

Colossians 3:3 — *For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.*

I am hidden in Christ.

1 John 5:18 — *We know that everyone who has been born of God does not keep on sinning, but he who was born of God protects him, and the evil one does not touch him.*

I am born of God and the evil one cannot touch me.

2 Timothy 1:7 — *For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.*

I do not have a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a sound mind.

1 Corinthians 3:16 — *Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?*

I am God's temple and His Spirit dwells in me.

MARRIAGE & FAMILY

Ephesians 5:31 — *Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.*

I am united with my spouse and we are one.

Hebrews 13:4 — *Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled, for God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterous.*

Our marriage will be honorable and pure before God.

Ephesians 5:25 — *Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her.*

As a husband, I will love my wife as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her.

Proverbs 31:28 — *Her children rise up and bless her; her husband also, and he praises her.*

As a husband, I will praise my wife.

1 Peter 3:7 — *Likewise, husbands, live with your wives in an understanding way, showing honor to the woman as the weaker vessel, since they are heirs with you of the grace of life, so that your prayers may not be hindered.*

As a husband, I will give my wife honor and live with her in an understanding way.

Proverbs 31:12 — *She does him good, and not harm, all the days of her life.*

As a wife, I will do my husband only good, never evil.

1 Peter 3:1 — *Likewise, wives be subject to your own husbands, so that even if some do not obey the word, they may be won without a word by the conduct of their wives.*

As a wife, I will influence my husband by obeying God.

OVERCOMING

Romans 8:31 — *What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?*

God loves me and is for me.

Matthew 19:26 — *But Jesus looked at them and said, “With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.”*

With God, all things are possible.

Philippians 4:13 — *I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.*

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

Psalms 27:1 — *The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?*

The Lord is my light and my salvation, I will fear no one.

Luke 10:19 — *“Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you.”*

I have authority to defeat the enemy and nothing will hurt me.

Romans 8:37 — *No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.*

I am more than a conqueror through Jesus Christ.

1 John 4:4 — *Little children, you are from God and have overcome them, for He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.*

He who is in me is greater than he who is in the world.

Isaiah 54:17 — *No weapon that is fashioned against you shall succeed, and you shall refute every tongue that rises against you in judgment. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD and their vindication from Me, declares the LORD.*

No weapon formed against me shall prosper.

Psalm 46:1-3 — *God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling.*

The Lord is my refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

Psalm 118:6-7 — *The LORD is on my side; I will not fear. What can man do to me? The LORD is on my side as my helper; I shall look in triumph on those who hate me.*

The Lord is on my side; I will not fear.

Luke 11:1 — *Now Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when He finished, one of His disciples said to Him, “Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples.”*

Lord, teach me to pray.

Philippians 4:6 — *Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.*

I will be anxious for nothing.

Psalm 122:6 — *Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: “May those who love you be secure.”*

I will pray for the protection of Israel and the city of Jerusalem.

Matthew 21:22 — *“And whatever you ask in prayer, you will receive, if you have faith.”*

I am believing that I will receive whatever I ask for in prayer.

John 16:24 — *“Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.”*

I will ask in Jesus’ name, and in receiving, my joy will be made full.

Mark 11:24 — *“Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.”*

I will believe that God will provide all my needs.

Romans 4:21 — *Fully convinced that God was able to do what He had promised.*

I am fully convinced that You are able to fulfill Your promises.

James 1:6 — *But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind.*

I will ask in faith, without doubting.

Psalm 37:4 — *Delight yourself in the LORD, and He will give you the desires of your heart.*

I will delight myself in the Lord, and He will give me the desires of my heart.

Matthew 26:41 — *“Watch and pray, that you do not enter into temptation. For the spirit is willing, but the flesh weak.”*

I will watch and pray so that I do not enter into temptation.

Jeremiah 29:13 — *“You will seek Me and find Me when you seek Me with all your heart.”*

When I search for You with all my heart, I will find you.

SPEECH

1 Thessalonians 5:11 — *Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.*

I will encourage others with my words.

Proverbs 18:21 — *Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruits.*

Life and death are in the power of my tongue.

Proverbs 15:1 — *A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.*

A soft answer turns away wrath.

James 1:19 — *Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger.*

I will be quick to hear, slow to speak, and slow to anger.

Colossians 4:6 — *Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person.*

I will always let my speech be filled with grace.

1 Peter 3:10 — *For whoever desires to love life and see good days, let him keep his tongue from evil and his lips from speaking deceit.*

My words influence my quality of life.

Titus 3:2 — *To speak evil of no one, to avoid quarreling, to be gentle, and to show perfect courtesy toward all people.*

I will speak evil of no one.

Psalms 19:14 — *Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer.*

My words and my thoughts will be pleasing to the Lord.

1 Peter 3:9 — *Do not repay evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary, bless, for to this you were called, that you may obtain a blessing.*

I will bless rather than return an insult.

Ephesians 4:31 — *Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice.*

I will put away all evil speech.

STEWARDSHIP

Proverbs 3:9-10 — *Honor the LORD with your possessions, and with the first fruits of all your increase; so your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine.*

My first financial priority is to honor the Lord.

1 Chronicles 29:16 — *“O Lord our God, as for all this abundance... it comes from Your hand, and all of it belongs to You.”*

All money comes from God, so all I have belongs to God.

Deuteronomy 8:18a — *“But remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you the ability to produce wealth...”*

The Lord gives me the ability to earn income.

Luke 16:10-11 — *“Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much. So if you have not been trustworthy in handling worldly wealth, who will trust you with true riches?”*

I will be a trustworthy and honest steward of finances.

Luke 6:38 — *“Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.”*

I will give money as an act of worship.

Malachi 3:10 — *“Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,” says the LORD Almighty, “and see if I will not throw open the floodgate of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it.”*

I will put God first in my finances.

1 Peter 4:10 — *God has given gifts to each of you from His great variety of spiritual gifts. Manage them well so that God’s generosity can flow through you.*

God’s generosity will flow through me.

Matthew 6:20-21 — *“But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”*

I will invest in the Kingdom of God.

Romans 13:8 — *Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for he who loves his fellow man has fulfilled the law.*

I will pay all my debts.

Proverbs 21:5 — *Good planning and hard work lead to prosperity, but hasty shortcuts lead to poverty.*

I will live by a biblical budget and prosper.

THE HOLY SPIRIT

John 4:24 — *“God is Spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the spirit and in truth.”*

God wants me to worship in the spirit and in truth.

John 16:13 — *“When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all the truth, for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak, and He will declare to you the things that are to come.”*

The Holy Spirit leads me into all truth.

Galatians 5:18 — *But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.*

I am led by the Spirit and am no longer under the law.

Luke 24:49 — *“And behold, I am sending the promise of My Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high.”*

I am clothed with power from the Holy Spirit.

John 16:7 — *“Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send Him to you.”*

The Holy Spirit is my Comforter and Helper.

Acts 1:8 — *“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”*

The Holy Spirit gives me power to witness.

Acts 4:29, 31 — *“And now, Lord, look upon their threats and grant to your servants to continue to speak Your Word with all boldness.” ...And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the Word of God with boldness.*

Being filled with the Holy Spirit gives me boldness.

Romans 8:26-27 — *Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. And He who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.*

The Holy Spirit intercedes for me according to God’s will.

John 14:26 — *“But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, He will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.”*

The Holy Spirit teaches and reminds me of all things.

THE WORD

John 1:1 — *In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.*

God has revealed Himself through His Word from the very beginning.

Hebrews 4:12 — *For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of souls and of spirit, of joints and marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.*

The Word is living and active.

Hebrews 11:3 — *By faith we understand that the universe was created by the Word of God so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible.*

All of creation was formed by the Word of God.

Psalm 119:11 — *I have stored up your Word in my heart, that I might not sin against You.*

I have hidden Your Word in my heart so that I might not sin against you.

Matthew 24:35 — *“Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will not pass away.”*

Heaven and earth will pass away, but Your Word stands forever.

John 6:63 — *“It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life.”*

Your words are spirit and life.

Psalm 119:105 — *Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.*

By Your words, I can see where I am going.

John 20:31 — *But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name.*

Through the Scriptures, I believe that Jesus is the Christ.

1 Peter 1:25 — *But the Word of the Lord remains forever. And this Word is the good news that was preached to you.*

The Word of the Lord endures forever.

John 14:15 — *“If you love Me, keep My commandments.”*

I love Jesus, therefore I keep His commandments.

WORSHIP

Deuteronomy 6:5 — *“Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.”*

I will love the Lord my God with all my heart, soul, and strength.

Matthew 4:10 — *“...You shall worship the Lord your God and Him only shall you serve.”*

John 4:24 — *“God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in the Spirit and in truth.”*

I will worship You in the Spirit and in truth.

2 Chronicles 20:19 — *And the Levites, of the Kohathites and the Korahites, stood up to praise the LORD, the God of Israel, with a very loud voice.*

I will stand up and praise the Lord God with a strong voice.

Psalm 103:1 — *Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless His holy name!*

I will bless the Lord.

Psalm 47:1-2 — *Clap your hands, all peoples! Shout to God with loud songs of joy! For the LORD, the Most High, is to be feared, a great king over all the earth.*

I will clap my hands and shout a song of joy.

Psalm 134:2 — *Lift up your hands to the holy place and bless the LORD!*

I will lift up my hands and bless the Lord.

Acts 4:24 — *And when they heard it, they lifted their voices together to God and said, "Sovereign Lord, who made the heaven and the earth and the sea and everything in them..."*

I will lift my voice to the Sovereign Lord.

Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.
