Biblical References for the Dream Team Honor Code

- **Abusing alcohol, drugs, or any substance that compromises your mind or body**

So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise. Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do. Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit.

- **Harmful gambling habits or other addictive behaviors**

But people who long to be rich fall into temptation and are trapped by many foolish and harmful desires that plunge them into ruin and destruction. - **Abusive language or gossip**

- **Using church relationships for personal or professional gain**

- **Pornography or any sexual activity outside of a biblically defined marriage**

But 'God made them male and female' from the beginning of creation. This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one.
